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## SPANISH TRANSFER PATHWAY

### A.A. DEGREE, 60 CREDITS

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### PURPOSE

The Spanish Transfer Pathway A.A. offers students a powerful option: the opportunity to complete an Associate of Arts degree with course credits that directly transfer to designated Spanish bachelor's degree programs at Minnesota State Universities. The curriculum has been specifically designed so that students completing the pathway degree and transferring to one of the seven Minnesota State Universities\* enter the university with junior-year status. All courses in the Transfer Pathway associate degree will directly transfer and apply to the designated bachelor's degree programs in a related field.

The Spanish Pathway consists of the Required Pathway Curriculum, the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC), the Health and Physical Fitness Requirement, and electives to bring your credit total to 60 credits.

*\*Universities within the Minnesota State system include Bemidji State University; Metropolitan State University; Minnesota State University, Mankato; Minnesota State University Moorhead; Southwest Minnesota State University; St. Cloud State University; and Winona State University.*

## Required Spanish Pathway Curriculum

The courses below must be completed successfully according to the university's grade standards and address the required outcomes in the transfer pathway for Spanish. Spanish courses beyond the requirements are not guaranteed to transfer into a Spanish major at a Minnesota State university; however, they may be taken to fulfill college and university electives.

\*Students with prior Spanish language experience who place at a higher-level are not required to take lower-level courses to complete the pathway. Students must still complete 60 credits within the designated distribution areas (MnTC & Health/Physical Education) to earn the Associate's degree.

## General Education Requirements 40 credits

The Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) requires a minimum of 40 credits, some of which will be satisfied by the required Spanish curriculum. You must complete the MnTC courses that are specifically designated below.
